• Smart Wiring

Smart wiring sends phone, TV and data signals around the house to provide maximum flexibility in your home.

Watch the lounge DVD player or Sky decoder on the bedroom TV. With an infrared repeating system you can change the sky channel or control the DVD player from any room.

Share computer files, printers and internet connections across your own computer network. Connect wireless access points for the ultimate in flexibility.

Connect the home phone line through to any room you like, add extra lines at any time without the need to add more cable.

Transfer phone calls around the home and make more use out of your fax or business line with a PABX, keeping the "home line" free for incoming calls.

Emerging technologies like media servers that store and play music and DVD's around the home will connect to your smart wiring system to deliver benefits into the future as they become available.





• Safety & Security

A safety and security system integrates intruder, life and fire protection in one simple, dependable package.

To achieve this level of protection we recommend a layered approach:

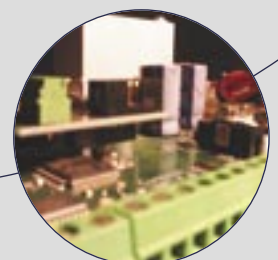
• **Beams** outside trigger plenty of floodlighting and sound a chime indoors.

• **Bugs** on the doors and windows activate the alarm before access is gained.

• **PIR** detectors back up the perimeter system.

Panic buttons by the master bed give total piece of mind.

Your security system incorporates smoke detectors which will be located near all bedrooms. Smoke will trigger the sirens and call monitoring to ensure help is on the way.

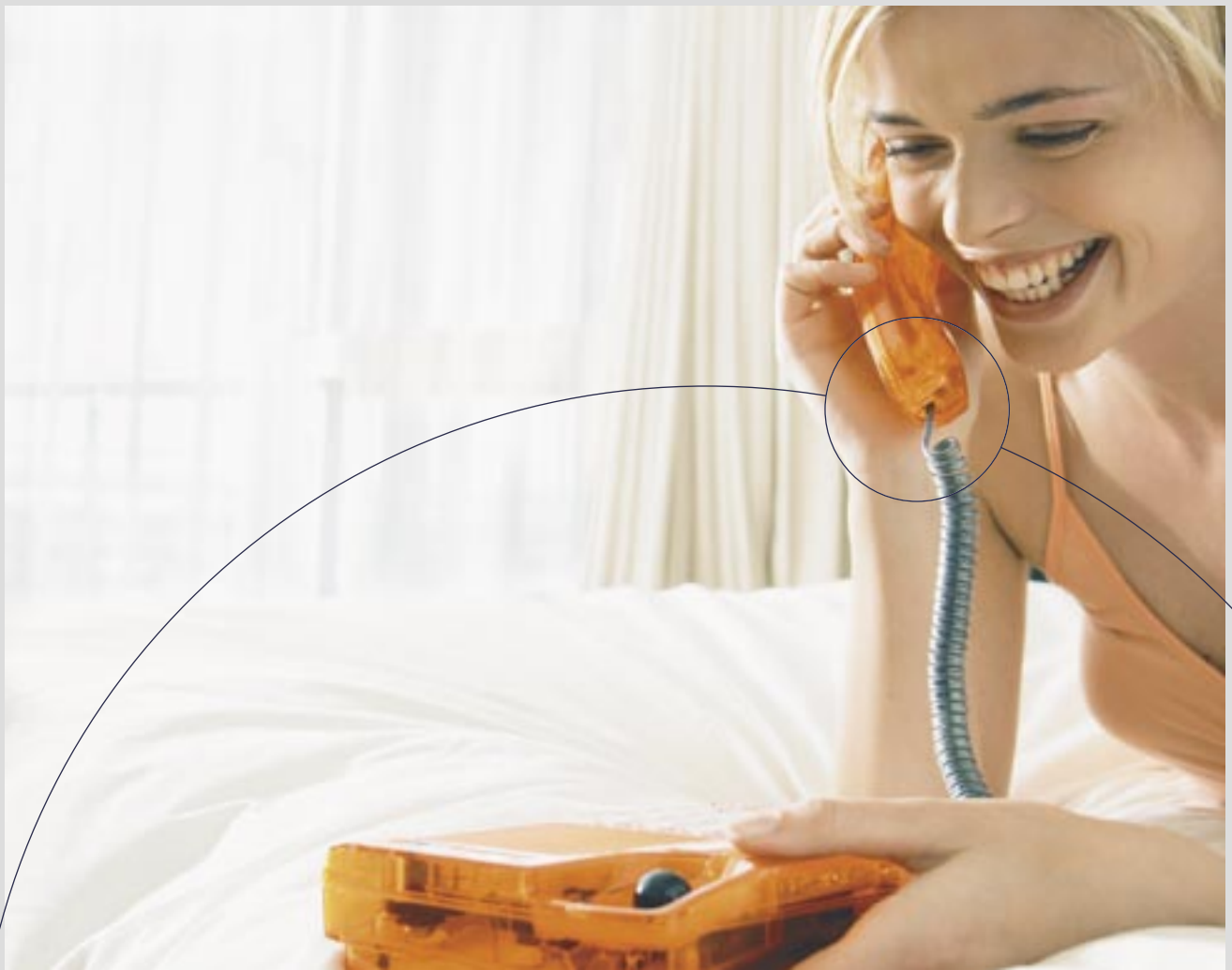
Imagine hearing your rubbish bins being knocked over in the middle of the night,

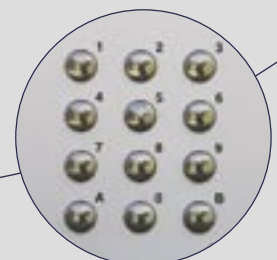


Access Control
